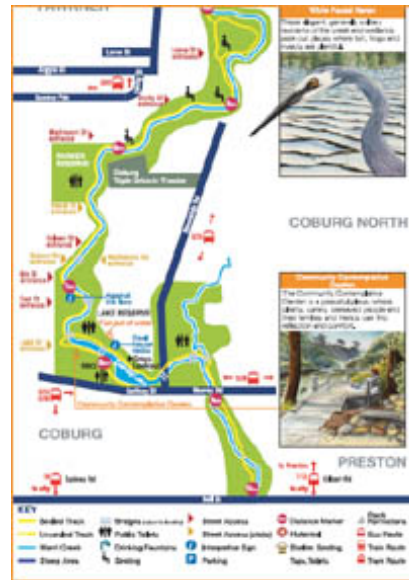
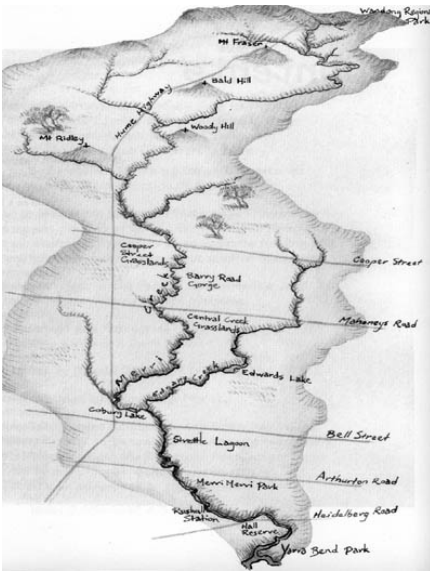


5/6 HOMEWORK TERM 3, WEEK 7
