2. A boxer dog called "Treasure" has "adopted 8 orphan piglets, feeding them and "mothering" them. How many legs did those piglets have altogether?



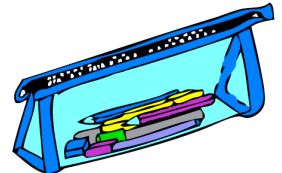
3. Tennis champion Serena Williams gave birth to a little girl, Alexis, last week. Baby Alexis weighed 3 kg. How many grams is that?
